

The International Armoured Vehicles 2023 fair brings together manufacturers and buyers of the world's deadliest weapons. Some of the 700+ attendees come from the most heinous human-rights-abusing governments and their suppliers including:

- Militaries and governments from over 40 countries, including repressive and corrupt regimes such as China, Turkey, Egypt, Saudi Arabia, the UAE and Bahrain, which don't hesitate to use them against their own citizens.
- Israel's Ministry of Defence Forces, which uses armoured vehicles with advanced surveillance technology to daily intimidate and abduct Palestinian adults and children living under illegal military occupation.
- 41 sponsors and exhibitors, including global arms trade leaders such as BAE systems, Leonardo and Rafael (an Israeli company which boasts that its weaponry is battle tested... on Palestinian civilians, including children).
- The arms trade has a devastating impact on our planet. It fuels armed conflict, violence against civilians and environmental destruction. It diverts scarce resources from human needs and is one of the world's most corrupt and polluting industries.

Arms fairs have been driven out of Bristol, Cardiff, Birmingham, Glasgow, Liverpool and Bath in recent years. Let's kick them out of Twickenham too!
