

This is an issue I have raised on a number of occasions with Tobias Ellwood, Minister of State for the Middle East. I was deeply concerned by the findings of the independent 2012 Children in Military Custody report. This report outlined no fewer than 40 recommendations for how Israel should improve the way they deal with arrests, interrogations, bail hearings, plea bargains, trials, sentencing, detention, complaints and monitoring. I am absolutely support my frontbench colleagues, in their calls for Israel to fully implement the outlined recommendations.
