

Labour is strongly committed to reducing human suffering caused by war. We will publish a strategy for protecting civilians in conflict, setting out detailed plans for work on conflict prevention and resolution, post conflict peacebuilding, and justice for the victims of war crimes. Labour has created a Minister for Peace and Disarmament to lead this work. Labour is committed to a comprehensive peace in the Middle East based on a two-state solution – a secure Israel alongside a secure and viable state of Palestine. There can be no military solution to this conflict and all sides must avoid taking action that would make peace harder to achieve. That means both **an end to the blockade, occupation and settlements**, and an end to rocket and terror attacks. Labour will continue to press for an immediate return to meaningful negotiations leading to a diplomatic resolution. **A Labour government will immediately recognise the state of Palestine.** As your MP, I would be proud to be part of the LFPME and join my Labour colleagues in supporting campaigns. Our Labour leader Jeremy Corbyn has also an excellent record as an advocate for Palestinian rights.
